

SAFA Campaign, Clean Air Initiative

1. Background

Clean Energy Nepal (CEN) has been implementing the “Safe and Clean Air for All” (SAFA) in Nepal, campaign with the financial support of US Department of State (FEDERAL ASSISTANCE AWARD). The SAFA campaign aims in promoting *Clean Air Initiatives* in Dhangadhi Sub-Metropolitan City (Dhangadhi), Birendranagar Municipality (Surkhet), Pokhara Metropolitan City (Pokhara), Siddharthanagar Municipality (Bhairahawa), Biratnagar Metropolitan City (Biratnagar), Illam Municipality (Illam) Janakpurdham Sub-Metropolitan City (Janakpur) and Kathmandu Metropolitan City (Kathmandu). Moreover, the campaign aims in informing, inspiring, engaging youths and other stakeholders for awareness and action on clean air campaign through the American Spaces networks in Nepal.

SAFA campaign *Clean air initiative grant* will provide grants to youth groups &/ individuals to work towards achieving clean air and curbing local air pollution. The SAFA campaign’s Clean Air Initiative grant expects to achieve clean air momentum in the cities by raising the awareness of stakeholders from wider group.

2. Objective:

Under the SAFA campaign Clean Air Initiative grant in Dhangadhi will be implemented with the following objective

- i. To actively engage young people in the clean air momentum.

3. Expected Outcome:

With the implementation of the SAFA campaign Clean Air Initiative grant, the following outcomes are expected

- i. Awareness is raised among the locals and stakeholders
- ii. Clean air momentum is brought forward

4. Geographical Extent:

The Clean Air Initiative grant will be supported for the implementation of the initiation in Dhangadhi itself. This will support the activities that will be conducted in the premises of Dhangadhi only.

5. Priorities for funding

The proposal which sounds timely submission committing to reduce air pollution, raising awareness, and advocating with the active and meaningful participation of local people, government and stakeholders will be priorities for funding.

6. Implementation

The proposal should contain a detailed plan of the activities that will be carried out during the implementation period. The proposal should include the expected target groups and number of activities that will undergo.

7. Timeframe :

The activities implementation period should be during September- December, 2022 and the final report submission should be made by December 2022.

8. Application procedure

The application will be accepted electronically to email address ([cen.comms@gmail](mailto:cen.comms@gmail.com) or info@cen.org.np) in a portable document format (.pdf) and budgets in separate excel file with the subject line “Proposal on Clean Air initiative to curb local air pollution”. Deadline for submission of proposals is September 11th, 2022, 5:00 p.m. Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered for evaluation.

9. Eligibility

The youths from Dhangadhi including Nepalese Youth for Climate Action (NYCA) working in the sector of environment contributing to reduction of air pollution.

10. Amount of grant available

The amount of the grant available is NPR. 3,00,000 (Rupees Three Lakhs only) under the SAFA campaign which will be subjected to tax (15%) .

II. Narrative Section

1. Executive Summary/Abstract (1page)
2. Introduction
3. Rationale: ½ page (Describe the importance of this project, why it should be done and what important contribution it will make in achieving clean air)
4. Description of the Project Site: 1/2page
5. Relation with SAFA campaign: 1 page (How does this project align with the SAFA campaign profile, priorities and objective)
6. Objective: 2-3 points, ½ page
7. Expected Outputs: 3-4 points, ½ page
8. Implementation modality and Proposed Activities
9. Others: CV of youth, if applicant is youth group: details of group member, Budget in Excel

Page margins: 1” all four sides
